Camden Alumni Association 2010 Scholarships

The Camden Alumni Association has announced the Student Scholarship Program for 2010. Up to six scholarships will be awarded to qualifying students who are graduating seniors in the current graduating class. To qualify a student must have a mother, father, step-parent, or legal guardian who was a graduate of Camden High School or Camden Central School; and must be accepted to a two or four year accredited college for the fall. Each scholarship will be for \$1,000.00. Students must complete a scholarship application form and return it to the High School Guidance office by Friday, March 5th. Scholarship application forms are available on the Camden Alumni Association website, www.camdenalumni.com. They will also be available in the Camden High School Guidance office in the spring semester.

Scholarships will be awarded based on the information provided in the form by the applying student. The Scholarship Committee members will review each application, determine the accuracy and completeness of the application, and each will confidentially select up to six candidates from among the applications. A secret vote will be taken among the committee members by the Scholarship Committee Chairperson (who is a non-voting) member to determine which applicants have the highest number of votes. In the event of a tie, a second vote will be taken as a tie-breaker. The applicants with the highest number of votes will be awarded a scholarship, with a maximum of six scholarships to be given for

the current round of awards.

The Camden Alumni Association takes great pride in the young men and women who comprise the current graduating class at Camden Central School, and hopes that this award may help the recipients reach their goals in life. The Camden Alumni Association Scholarship Fund is supported through donations from alumni and from anyone else wishing to make a contribution. Contributors can make general donations, or memorial donations in the name of some individual or individuals. All donations can be included when returning the Registration Form and Ballot for the Annual Meeting and Banquet, or can be made directly anytime, by making a check payable to: Camden Alumni Association Scholarship Fund. As with last year, our timeline is shorter than in past years. In the past, applications have had to be handed in by the first Friday in May, in order for the Scholarship Committee to make their selection in time for Class Night in late June. Class night will be earlier this year, so we will need all of the applications by the first Friday in March, March 5th.
